

Sunday morning stroll. Want to stretch your legs and take in a church service or simply build up an appetite for a lunchtime beer. This walk which is just a couple of miles from the cottage, along a pretty stretch of the Liverpool to Leeds canal will fill the bill. A flat walk which is there and back, you decide the length. A handy barge near the beginning/end will usually provide you with a tea or an ice cream.

Park close to the church and walk up the steps towards the church main door. Pass to the left of the church building and through the grave stones, up a few steps towards a bridge over the canal.



Just before you pass over the canal, turn left to go down a few steps to join the tow path.



Turn left onto the tow path. Now simply walk for as far as you desire before turning back to retrace your steps.





It is a very pretty walk. There is usually a barge serving tea/coffee and cakes and ice creams on the opposite side of the canal a short distance from the start. It is by a small bridge which you can use to reach the far side.
