Coach House Walk Description

GPX – A GPX file is a data description of a route(walk) that can be imported into a map App so that the user can see exactly where they are on the map in real time without an internet connection.

The tracks and GPX files have been exported from OS maps, so the simplest way to follow a route is using the OS map App. This can be purchased for £3.99 for a month and covers the whole country. This is the option which we would recommend and will give you your exact position on the map without an internet connection.

Besides the OS App there are a number of other walking Apps that the GPX files can be used with and give the same facilities. Simply download the GPX file and when opening it choose the App that you want to open it with. Some of these Apps purport to be free but generally when you drill down, if you want offline real time tracking there will be a charge.
